Eastern IFCA Closed Areas Byelaw 2021 Informal Consultation: Questionnaire

Eastern IFCA are considering new management in two locations:

- The Lincolnshire Coast: we are investigating the need for closures to bottomtowed gear in the inshore section of the Inner Dowsing, Race Bank, and North Ridge Special Area of Conservation (SAC).
- Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds Marine Conservation Zone (MCZ), North Norfolk
 Coast: we are investigating the need to restrict netting activity (fixed nets and drift nets) within the zone.

We are seeking to learn more about fishing activity in these areas. This will help us to understand the impact that management may have on activity, resulting in better informed decisions.

2. Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds MCZ

Eastern IFCA are seeking **more evidence on netting activity** (fixed nets and drift nets) on the Cromer Shoal Chalk Beds MCZ. Information about the effort level and location of activity will inform if management of netting on the site is required.

It is very useful to see in person, or in a photo, the gear used on the site to better understand any potential impact. If you fish using nets on the MCZ an officer may contact you to arrange gathering this information.

The outline of area 2 (marked on the chart in orange) is based on currently available evidence that we have of the location of the 'rugged chalk'. The exact outline of this area is under review.
