Mariners are advised that the anchoring equipment lost to the north of No.1 light buoy has been located and is now marked by a yellow special mark buoy with light character FI (5) Y 10s.

The area of designated foul ground (*) is now a circle of diameter 100m centred on the following position: 52°56.462' N 00° 21.523' E.

*Foul Ground is defined as "as an area of foul ground, not dangerous to surface navigation, but to be avoided by vessels anchoring, trawling etc".

The chart symbol for foul ground is a pecked line surrounding a # symbol.

Operations to fully recover the equipment along with the buoy are scheduled to be undertaken within the week subject to weather.

Craft involved in subsequent operations to locate and recover the equipment are to be given a wide berth and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch. 14 & 16.
