- b) No. 22 light buoy to be moved approx. 105m x 355°(T) to 52° 50'.415N 00°21'.750E
- c) No. 23 light buoy to be moved approx. 125m x 165°(T) to 52° 49'.865N 00°21'.540E
- d) "R" light buoy to be moved approx. 165m x 000°(T) to 52° 49'.390N 00°21'.345E

All the above works will be carried out by the buoying vessel St Edmund and all mariners are requested to pass at slow speed and give as wide a berth as is possible whilst works are being carried out. Contact the St Edmund on VHF Ch. 14 for further information.
